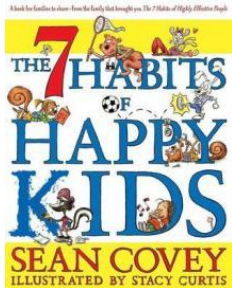
Homework is due on **Thursday** each week. Please check in with your student during the week and have him/her come to seek help if they are experiencing difficulty after attempting the homework.

Just reminders to please check your student's Homework Binders each night and sign the calendar.



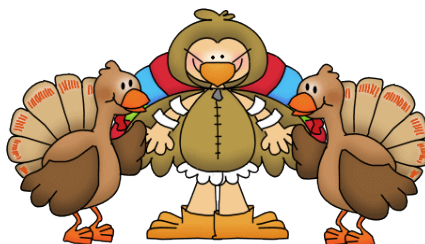
Items to note:
