


Word Study:

Here are some reading strategies to help ensure that you understand what you are reading and that you choose the BEST possible answer choice:

- 1. Read all of the questions *first*.
- 2. Read the passage, highlighting or underlining any important facts or details as you go.
- 3. Reread the questions (not the answer choices- YET!).
- 4. Look to the passage for details that support your answer. PROVE that you are correct.
- 5. Read the possible answer choices rule out which ones it cannot be, then consider carefully the specific details of the remaining choices.
- 6. Always select the BEST choice available.
